



ITINERARY

Quad 3 Days / 2 Nights (Kei Mouth to Kob Inn)

DAY 1

We meet at the small coastal resort of Kei Mouth (90km's). You begin the ride by crossing the Great Kei River (former border between the Republic of South Africa and the Republic of Transkei) via the only motorised pontoon in South Africa.

After a brief orientation, your journey will take you off the beaten track. The professionally guided route will follow ancient sledge paths ground out by ox-drawn sledges. Scenic river crossings and negotiating daunting obstacles will ensure an awesome experience. Visit Nongqawuse's pool. This historic site is steeped in legends and tradition. Relive the "National Xhosa Suicide". Visit the Jacaranda Wreck, one of the many ships claimed on the Wild Coast. Relive the tragedy surrounding this spectacular sight. A mound close by, left by the Koi people, is filled with ancient artefacts and relics of a forgotten people. A short journey brings us to the Kobonqaba River Mouth, the southern most White Mangrove swamps in Africa.

After many challenging river crossings and awe-inspiring scenery, we arrive at Mazeppa Bay Island, a fisherman's paradise. Enjoy a walk across the suspension bridge. Prepare yourself for the exciting gorge crossing (Qora river), a steep gorge that is truly beautiful and fairly challenging. Some guests prefer to walk out while our guide drives the quads out. You arrive at Kob Inn just before sunset. Overnight at Kob Inn.

DAY 2

After a restful evening and enjoying a hearty breakfast you're off to experience another exciting day in the saddle. Heading north towards the Shixini and Ngabara Rivers, this outing offers wonderful vantage points to take in the beautiful stretches of beaches, not to mention the undulating grass hills and steep cliffs which are the order of the day. Then after a day of sights and memory making in the rugged outdoors its back to Kob Inn for another mouth-watering meal and refreshing night's sleep.

DAY 3

Day three marks the beginning of the homeward bound leg of the journey. After breakfast the team rides out back towards Kei Mouth via a slightly different, yet equally challenging route. On reaching the Kei Mouth crossing, the quads are ridden onto the ferry and the rider's head home.
